What to bring:

1. **student ID card**

2. Your urine sample (collect early morning urine sample on the day of check up)

*Collect urine sample even when you are having your period, and let us know about it.

3. Questionnaire for medical checkup (Do not bend or fold)

The Questionnaire is placed at the same site where "pee pole" is located. Questionnaire can be completed on the day of checkup, however, it is highly recommended to complete it in advance.

Notes:

1. In physical measurement (height/weight) and Chest X-ray, you need to take off your shoes and clothes. It is advisable not to wear boots nor one piece dress and take all of accessories off.

Chest X-ray examination can be performed with a pale-colored T-shirt without any patterns/drawings, buttons, beadwork and metal fittings.

2. Those who need to get a result of a Chest X-ray exam for taking a class of teaching practice or nursing care practice, please make sure to undergo the Chest X-ray exam on Apr.12. The certificate (the result of Chest X-ray exam) will be issued at Suita Health Care Center on April 30 from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm.

3. During the medical checkup, general medical consultation service will not be available in Suita Health Care Center. Please visit Toyonaka or Minoh Health Care Center for medical consultation (Please see office hour on the web site.)

4. Suita Health Care Center is likely to be crowded with students on the last day so please visit at your earliest convenience.

A certificate of medical check-up and the result:

1. The certificate for academic year of 2010 will be issued from June 1 (Tuesday) at each Health Care Center (or machine). Also, the result will be available on KOAN web site.

2. The certificate for academic year of 2009 may be issued at each Health Care Center until May 31 except April 4-6

The certificate will not be issuable at Suita Health Care Center between April 9 and 28. Please visit Toyonaka or Minoh Health Care Center.

3. The medical certificate will not be issued if you do not take the medical checkup in academic year of 2010.

Regulations for students (Medical Checkup)(学生健康診断規程)

<The obligation of the medical examination>(受診の義務)

1. Students are required to undergo a medical checkup.

2. If students chose not to receive medical checkup during the period, the students will be responsible for taking a medical checkup on their own expense and should submit the certificate including the results of the examination items above.
